

**Re: REQUEST FOR AN AMENDMENT TO DRILL TWO 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" HOLES, TEMPORARILY CONNECT CONSPEC CABLES AND WATER LINE FROM THE COTTONWOOD MINE TO THE TRAIL MOUNTAIN MINE, PACIFICORP, COTTONWOOD MINE, ACT/015/019, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH.**

PacificCorp requests that an amendment be granted to allow two 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" diameter horizontal holes to be drilled from the Cottonwood mine workings approximately 150' to the surface. The holes will be cased at 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" diameter and used to bring a Conspec Mine Monitoring Cable, Underground Telephone line and a 2" High Pressure Hose to the surface.

The cables will be run along the terrace above the subsoil pile on the Cottonwood side and then suspended across the Emery County Road 00506 at a minimum of 18' to the Trail Mountain Mine. The high pressure hose will be routed through the culvert system from the Cottonwood side to the Trail Mountain Mine. This installation is to be temporary until the Tube Conveyor Amendment is approved and the conveyor is constructed, at which time the cables and water line will be incorporated into the Tube Conveyor. A map depicting the locations is enclosed for your review. The connection of the cables and hose needs to take place immediately to continue mining at the Trail Mountain Mine.


An encroachment application has been submitted to Emery County for crossing road 00506 and should be approved by February 17, 1995.

Public participation and comment has already occurred in association with the disturbed area for the Cottonwood Fan Portal area. This amendment will take place within the existing disturbed area.

No increase in the bond will be associated with this amendment. The Reclamation Plan for the Tube Conveyor and the Cottonwood Fan Portal will remain the same.




