RE: Surface Facilities Drawing, Disturbed Boundary Line, PacifiCorp, Cottonwood Mine, ACT/015/019-97H, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

Summary.

PacifiCorp, in converting mine maps from a manual to an automated system, overlooked including the disturbed boundary on the surface facilities map, drawing #WS4490.

This matter was addressed in a prior DOGM inspection report by the undersigned. The permittee has submitted a permit amendment application that corrects this oversight together with corrected maps.

Engineering, 512.100 - Cross Section and Maps

Analysis

Maps required to be included in a permit application will be prepared under direction of a certified and registered professional engineer. In converting maps from a manual system to an automated system the disturbed boundary was inadvertently not included on the automated map.

Findings

- (1) The attached map depicts the disturbed map area as posted on the ground. Further, the boundary line is marked by uniform disturbed markers.
- (2) The application meets the requirement of the Utah Coal Rules.

Recommendation

Recommend the permit amendment application be approved as submitted.
