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

RE: Amendment No. 2 to BLM Right-of-Way Grant UTU-65027 - Relinquish Temporary Use (Staging) Area and Provide Corrected As-Built Description, PacifiCorp's Cottonwood Mine Waste Rock Disposal Site, Emery County, Utah

Dear Mr. Manus:

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly own subsidiaries Interwest Mining Company (as managing agent) and Energy West Mining Company (as mine operator), hereby submits this notification to (1) relinquish the temporary use (staging) area which was secured under Amendment No. 1 granted effective 9/14/90, and (2) provide a corrected as-built description of the entire right-of-way area to include two small areas (totaling .36 acres) as a result of the initial construction work. The attached Exhibit A contains the as-built legal description of the area we wish to have retained within BLM right-of-way grant UTU-65027 and is shown on the enclosed drawing no. CM-10826-WB revised 12-6-99. The attached Exhibit B (8½" x 11" drawing number KS1794A) depicts the area of relinquishment (temporary staging area approximately 1.78 acres) from UTU-65027.

The temporary staging area is a site that was previously disturbed by drilling activities not associated with PacifiCorp nor it's mining operations. This relinquishment of the temporary staging area is caused by Texaco's desire drill a well on these same lands. With Texaco's planned drilling activities to utilize this same area, it is our understanding that the reclamation obligations of this site belongs to Texaco. All other terms and conditions of BLM grant no. UTU-65027 will remain the same as the original grant effective 6/8/90.

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
