

Please be advised that there are no discharge exceedances to report for the month of May with the exception of the Deer Creek Mine discharge (UPDES permit number UT0023604-002). Total Iron exceeded the effluent gross value of 1.0 mg/L by 0.1 mg/L. Suspended Solids sampled from the discharge water was elevated but still within the permit requirement. Typically, Total Iron values will increase as Suspended Solids values increase.
