Re: Clean Copy Submittal of the Approved Waste Rock Site Amendment, C/015/019-00A Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine, PacifiCorp, C/015/019, Emery County, Utah.

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company (Energy West) hereby submits three (3) additional clean copies of the amendment C/015/019-00A without the 12/20/99 revision of Volume 1, Part 1, Legal and Financial. This amendment was submitted January 11, 2000. A letter assigning conditional approval (dated February 20, 2001) was received in our office in February, 2001 (due April, 16, 2001). The conditional approval required PacifiCorp to submit corrected legal descriptions of the Cottonwood/Wilberg permit area which included squaring off the northern permit boundary to simplify the legal description.

Three attachments are included with this submittal. The first attachment includes seven (7) copies of the revised Part 1 (revision date 4/16/01) of the Cottonwood/Wilberg MRP. The entire section has been reformatted, updated, and replaced. Routinely changing information (i.e. Officer and Director Lists, NOV, etc.) has been placed into appendices. This should make future amendments to the MRP more efficient and less confusing. Also, included is the Table of Contents and Introduction for the Cottonwood/Wilberg MRP. The TOC has been adjusted to accommodate the 4/16/01 revision of Part 1. The Introduction Section has been adjusted to reflect a May, 2000 amendment. Please review, stamp, and return one (1) copy so it can be incorporated into the Cottonwood/Wilberg MRP.

The second attachment includes seven (7) copies of Plates 1-1 (Subsurface Ownership) and 1-2 (Surface Ownership) of the Cottonwood/Wilberg MRP. These maps exhibit revised northern boundary of the Cottonwood/Wilberg permit area. The boundary replicates the northern lease boundary of U-083066, U-040151, and the Fee property of the LDS Church in sections 15, 16, 17, and 18 in Township 17 South, Range 7th East and Section 13 in Township 17 South, Range 6th East. This permit boundary reduces the permit size approximately 3007 acres (area calculated using AutoCAD and not coal plats).

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
The existing northern permit boundary follows the extent of the thinning Hiawatha seam below a 5 foot thickness. The boundary is impossible to accurately describe and ,therefore, is proposed to be relocated along the said lease line. This placement will enable the permittee to give an accurate legal describe the permit area. Please review, stamp, and return one (1) copy of each so it can be incorporated into the Cottonwood/Wilberg MRP.

Upon approval of Attachments 1 and 2, PacifiCorp will submit revisions to other maps that are affected by the permit boundary relocation.

The third attachment includes three (3) additional clean copies of amendment C/015/019-00A without the 12/20/99 revision of Volume 1, Part 1. The 12/20/99 revision submitted January 11, 2000 did not accurately describe the permit area as required by the Division Order received February 17, 2000. Please discard Part 1, dated 12/20/99, and stamp [Approved] Appendix VII and Plate 4-1 (CM-10826-WB) and return one (1) copy each so it can be incorporated into the Cottonwood/Wilberg MRP.
