We have reviewed the proposal to reduce the permit area. Only a small portion (approx. 180 acres) of the proposed reduction area lies on National Forest System lands in Federal Coal Lease U-47978. This area has not been mined under and subsidence monitoring indicates that no subsidence has occurred nor is likely to occur in the area. The adjacent reclaimed Miller Canyon breakout would remain in the permit area. We have no objection to the proposed permit area reduction.
