Enclosed is UPDES permit No. UT0022896 for your facility. Copies of EPA form 3320-1, Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) forms, for reporting and self-monitoring requirement as specified in the permit, will be sent as soon as printed. This permit will become effective on November 1, 2002, subject to the right of appeal in accordance with the provisions of *Utah Administrative Code*, Sections R317-8-6.11 and R317-8-6.13.

A fee schedule was included in the Utah Department of Environmental Quality Budget appropriation request at the direction of the Legislature and in accordance with *Utah Code Annotated* 19-1-201. The fee schedule, as approved by the legislature, includes a prescribed fee for specific Industrial Categories. The prescribed fee for an Industrial category, Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit is \$3,600.00. Please remit \$3,600.00 within 30 days from receipt of this letter to:
