Dennis,

As we discussed, the changes weren't everything I wanted, but they appear to be workable. It will come down to whether or not self-reclamation has adequately done the job when the time comes for final bond release. If there is no off-site sedimentation or other off-site impact, no formation of rills and gullies or other on-site erosion, the ditches are filling with sediment and disappearing into the natural setting, and appropriate vegetation is providing adequate cover, then the plan you have proposed will have been sufficient. If it becomes evident with time that the proposed methods are not working, this plan will need to be revisited. The plan itself doesn't determine final bond release; the results are what will determine that.

If you opened my previous e-mail before I recalled it, the last line wasn't correct. You need to submit these changes in your response to the Oct 31 TA, then I can do (what we both hope will be) the final TA.
