Re: Submittal to Amend Volume 1: Table of Contents and Volume 5: Map 3-1 Life of Mine Plan Hiawatha Coal Seam CM-10807-WB, PacifiCorp, Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine, C/015/019, Emery County, Utah.

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits Map 3-1 Life of Mine Hiawatha Coal Seam to satisfy concerns expressed by the Bureau of Land Management following the approval of the permit area reduction of the Cottonwood Mine. The permit area reduction (C/015/019-AM00A) was approved on September 13, 2002. This approval reduced the Cottonwood permit area from approximately 10,600 acres to 6,886.88 acres. Application AM00A included plates 1-1 and 1-2 of Volume 3. All of the remaining maps related to permit area reduction were submitted on February 26, 2003 and approved for incorporation on March 26, 2003. These maps have been incorporated into the MRP. The following lists the changes involved in this amendment:

	Page xii	Plate 3-2 (Map CM-10808-WB) in Volume 5 (5 year mine plan in the Blind Canyon seam) was removed as part of the February 26, 2003 amendment. The currently approved R2P2 only includes reserves in the Hiawatha Seam which are shown on Plate 3-1, Map CM-10807-WB.




