We've have reclaimed the large rill on the CFP area. This was completed shortly after the rain event in 2000. As far as the self reclamation of the upper terrace, it is reclaiming itself. The upper end has filled in with sediment and vegetation. Runoff has begun to follow the natural drainage pattern. I have attached before and after pictures of large rill area and the upper part of the upper terrace to show the successful rehabilitation of these areas.

In preparation of Phase II and III bond release, we will began removing the sediment traps; one on the upper terrace, and four on the lower terrace. We will place natural rock in the locations of the traps to slow overland flow. If you have any concerns of this removal, please let me know as we will start this week.
