Re: Permit Renewal for the Cottonwood Mine, PacifiCorp, C/015/0019, Emery County, Utah.

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Interwest Mining Company ("Interwest") as mine operator, hereby submits an application for permit renewal for the Cottonwood Mine. The current permit term expires July 6, 2019. The said application conforms to the requirements set forth in R645-300-120 and R645-303-230 of the State of Utah R645- Coal Mining Rules and Regulations, revised March 2009.

As required in R645-303-232.250 and R645-301-830.300, the Means Historical Cost Index has been escalated to the year 2016 as the result of the mid-term review in 2011. A surety bond is held (payable to the Division) in the amount of \$2,779,000.00, as shown in the Permit. Enclosed with this application is a proposed public notice, proof of liability insurance, and evidence of a performance bond to remain in effect for the operation as required by R645-303-232. One Notice of Violation has been received by Interwest within the last 3 years. A signed statement is included indicating the NOV status of the Interwest mines.

The Cottonwood/Wilberg mine has been completely reclaimed during the last permit term. Interwest has submitted a permit amendment to add as-built maps and drawings to the permit indicating that the mine site has been completely reclaimed. This amendment has been approved by the Division. PacifiCorp/Interwest has applied for Phase I Bond Release for the Cottonwood Mine site as of March 4, 2019. An illustration of the projected bond reduction is included.

Final reclamation of this area was completed in November 2014.

** The total disturbed area of the Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine Site increased to 22.0 acres from 20.46 acres in part as a result of the reclamation activities. The main reason however, is that an aerial survey of the site was conducted in 2018 using high resolution photogrammetric imagery. The post reclamation disturbed area boundary was digitized using the ortho photo in AutoCAD where a flat plane area was calculated.

Final reclamation of the mine site area was completed in March 2018.



With this transmittal, we are providing the following to update the Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine Reclamation Agreement accordingly:


