The site is completely pock to control sediment leaving the site. I did not see any signs of sediment leaving this site.

8. Noncoal Waste

The site was clean of non-coal waste materials such as trash, oil cans, wood and scrap materials.

10. Slides and Other Damage

No slides or other damage was noticed during the inspection. The reclamation site appears to be stable.

12. Backfilling And Grading

The site is completely backfilled and graded.

13. Revegetation

Vegetation is growing within the pocks. Mostly grasses are in the pocks.


