THE DIVISION OF OIL, GAS, AND MINING, having conducted an inspection of the Co-op Mining Company's Co-op Mine, located at Section 22, Township 16 South, Range 7 East, Emery County, Utah and finding said operation to be in violation of Orders of the Board of Oil, Gas, and Mining of November 29, 1978 and February 28, 1979, as well as finding that said operation has failed to abate notices of violation issued July 23, 1979 and September 25, 1979 as detailed in Appendix A hereto;

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to Section 40-10-22, Utah Code Annotated, the Division hereby issues an immediate cessation order halting all mining activities at the Co-op Mine, Emery County, Utah and requesting the Co-op Mining Company to appear before the Division and Board of Oil, Gas, and Mining at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 19, 1979 in the Connestoga Room of the Holiday Inn, 1659 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah to show cause why the Board and Division should not permanently enjoin said operations.
