The above-mentioned mine was given a partial inspection on November 19, 1980. Joe Helfrich, Tom Portle and Sandy Pruitt of the Division, Larry Damrau and Claire Sullivan, Environmental Scientist, of OSM briefly toured the mine-site while looking for Wendell Owen to accompany us on an inspection of the Trail Canyon Mine. One area of concern was noted, this should be examined by the operator during the next inspection.

The newly installed cross culvert for the main access road at the upper end of the material storage yard has a hole in the metal where Bear Creek bends to pass through the culvert. This hole will allow water to circuit around the culvert if not repaired.

Welding on the tippie was underway. There was no evidence of other activity. No violations were issued.
