Gentlemen:

Request is hereby made for an investigation, expedited hearing and temporary relief from the penalties and requirement of N83-5-3-1, N82-5-2-10 and N83-5-1-4, issued by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.

The reasons for this request are that the Division and Board have not followed the requirements of Section 40-10-20(2), U.C.A., and the assessments are unreasonable and unjustified. The financial burden imposed upon Co-op Mining Company by these and other assessments threaten Co-op's ability to continue operating and will cause Co-op to suffer irreparable loss and damage.

Furthermore, the notices, particularly N83-5-3-2, do not comply with the requirements of UMC 843.12(b)(2), and Co-op is at a loss as to what can be done to abate the alleged violations.

Your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.
