On June 14, 1983 Lynn Kunzler, Mary Boucek and Joe Helfrich of the Division and Ron Joseph of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) met with Bill Stoddard and Dennis White of Co-op to survey powerlines for compliance with UMC 817.97 (c). The powerline from the mouth of the canyon to the proposed shop/bathhouse area were constructed of a "safe" design. The 3 poles (with crossarms) at the proposed shop/bathhouse area as well as the 3 poles in the portal area near the substation were not of a "safe" design.

Upon receipt of a written report from the USFWS, the Division will make recommendations on how to modify poles to comply with raptor protection technology.
