The Division has reviewed your submittal of April 8, 1983. Approval is hereby granted to change the drainage area described as undisturbed to disturbed as requested under Violation #2 of 2 for NOV 83-5-2-2 (see enclosed copy). Plans must now be initiated to design the sedimentation control structures and associated drainage control measures using this assumption. These designs must insure no drainage from the disturbed area mixes with undisturbed drainage and the sediment pond sizing incorporates this drainage. Viking Engineering may contact the Division with any questions that may arise on this matter.

VIOLATION 2 OF 2 for NOTICE OF VIOLATION 83-5-2-2

The Co - Op Mining Company, has tentatively approved the recommendation from Viking Engineering Services to reassign the drainage in question in NOV 83-5-2-2 as ~~disturbed~~. The location of the overcast material, sizing plant, and a questionable ditch, points to the reasoning behind this change. Adjustments will be made to assure the drainage from this area no longer enters the undisturbed drainage culvert. Upon final approval of this change, adjustments will be determined for the sizing of the main sedimentation pond. Please contact Viking Engineering for questions on sizing etc.
