The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) and Co-op Mining Company (Co-op) state that they have resolved and agreed to settle all matters relating to the appeal of mining violations N83-5-9-1, C83-1-3-1, N83-5-2-2, 2 of 2, and C83-1-2-1.

Accordingly, both parties have entered into this settlement agreement which is set forth as follows:

1. The Division agrees to vacate N83-5-9-1 and ⁶⁰C83-1-3-1 which were based upon possible soil contamination due to oil spillage from untested transformers. Co-op and the Division have collected soil samples from the


affected area to test for the presence of toxic materials.
Co-op agrees to perform any remedial reclamation of the
affected site.

2. Co-op agrees to dismiss its appeal of mining
violation NOV 83-5-2-2, 2 of 2, and C 83-1-2-1.
