RE: Meeting with Co-op Mining
Company Regarding Sediment
Pond Violation
Bear Creek Canyon Mine
ACT/015/025, Folder No. 7
Emery County, Utah

The nature of the meeting was to discuss a suitable abatement to Violation N83-5-8-3, #2 of 3, dealing with the presentation of adequate plans for their sediment pond. Co-op Mining was represented by Mel Coonrod and Mr. Wimmer, a hydrologic engineer.

The information submitted by Co-op Mining in their MRP was reviewed and a letter sent to Co-op Mining on January 30, 1984 listing various inadequacies in their existing plan. They reviewed each of the inadequacies and discussed them with Tom Munson, Division hydrologist.

Two issues were left undecided at the end of the meeting and they have since been resolved. These issues were the sediment pond embankment stability and the sediment storage level. Co-op representatives Mel Coonrod and Mr. Wimmer were contacted by phone on February 16, 1984 and made aware of the Division's decision to require embankment stability tests and to recommend .1 ac-ft/ac sediment storage for design consideration.
