Ten-Day Notice to the State of UTAH

You are notified that, as a result of Federal Oversight Insp. 2/26/85 (e.g. a federal inspection, citizen information, etc.) the Secretary has reason to believe that the person described below is in violation of the Act or a permit condition required by the Act.
