**NOTICE OF PERMIT APPROVAL**

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated 1983, Section 40-10-1 et seq.) and "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Mining Activities" (Final Rules of the Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining), the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has issued a permit to mine coal to Co-Op Mining Company for application No. ACT/855/855. The Company will mine and reclaim in accordance with the approved Reclamation Plan for the Bear Canyon Mine associated with the land and the following lands:

Township 18 South, Range 7 East  
 Sec. 14: SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Sec. 23: E $\frac{1}{2}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Secs. 24 and 25: All west of the north-south Bear Canyon Fault.

Sec. 26: N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , portions of the Bear Canyon Road beginning at the end of county maintenance and running northeast to the intersection of Section 26, and a small stockpile of approximately two acres beginning in portions of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ .

This permit was approved by the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining on October 21, 1985.
