The applicant has not met the requirements of my technical memo of May 16, 1986 or the topics discussed in an office meeting held with Dan Guy, consultant to CO-OP Mining, on June 16, 1986.

In that informal office meeting with Dan Guy, I specifically pointed out that all the material be adequate for insertion into the MRP, all plates and figures be certified by a professional engineer and that the post-mining sampling points be shown on Plate 7-7a and be verbally referenced in the text. Plate 7-7a is not certified, the location and discussion of sampling post-mining drainage to meet the requirements of state and federal effluent limitations has not been included in the text, and there are no page numbers or instructions of where this submittal is to be inserted into the mine plan.
