Synopsis of Proposal

Co-Op Mining Company (Co-Op) is temporarily storing lump coal on the Scale House pad, occupying about a one-half acre area. The letter from Co-Op Mining dated July 19, 1988 outlined the two justifications for this temporary coal storage pad: convenience and safety for Co-Op customers.

Analysis

Co-Op must identify a permanent location for the temporary coal storage area on the surface facilities map (Plate 2-2) required by UMC 784.23[b][4]. The narrative in the PAP must incorporate a description of the use, maintenance and removal of this coal storage area (UMC 784.11[b][3]).

Recommendations

The applicant must provide the above-mentioned information for insertion into the PAP before the Division can approve this proposal.

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
