Re: Notice of Failure to Provide Required Responses to PAP Amendments,
ACT/015/025-87A, ACT/015/025-87E, and ACT/015/025-87F, Co-Op Mining
Company, Bear Canyon Mine, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

This letter is provided as a follow-up to previous letters forwarded to you regarding the following permit amendments: Minor Cave to Surface/Emergency Escape & Ventilation Portal; Minor Hydrologic Design Changes/Lower Seam Portal Area; and Deletion of Road Culverts from Approved MRP. The above referenced amendment reference numbers correspond respectively.

Copies of the last Division correspondence regarding each of these amendments are attached to this letter for your reference. The Division has recently established a permitting policy which requires an informal contact with the operator when the operator's response is 30 days overdue. When the response is 60 days overdue, the Division may formally withdraw/deny the permit request, or establish a mandatory deadline for receipt of the delinquent response. The specific action warranted depends on the nature of the permitting action. If the operator fails to meet a mandatory deadline without just cause, then appropriate enforcement action will be taken.

Unless our records are in error, all three of these PAP amendments are now at least 80 days overdue. Therefore, the Division hereby establishes April 30, 1988 as a final deadline for receipt of the required information necessary to finalize these permitting actions. Please contact us at your earliest convenience if your correspondence records indicate otherwise.


