Re: Approval of Extensions for Co-Op Mining Company, NOV N-88-5-1-1, Trail Canyon Mine, ACT/015/021, Folder #5, and Mid-Term Review and Lease Addition, Bear Canyon Mine, ACT/015/025, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

This letter is in reply to your correspondence dated September 22, 1988, requesting extensions for Items 1 and 3 of NOV N-88-5-1-1, and extensions for the response for mid-term review and lease addition at the Bear Canyon Mine.

The requested extensions are granted with one exception, as noted below in Item 1.

1. Response to N-88-5-1-1, Item No. 1, Trail Canyon Mine, extended until 5 p.m. October 14, 1988;
2. Response to N-88-5-1-1, Item No. 3, extended until 5 p.m. October 31, 1988;
3. Mid-Term Review, Bear Canyon Mine, response due date extended until November 14, 1988
4. Lease addition, Bear Canyon Mine - Response target date extended until November 14, 1988.

It should be noted that the target date for the response on the lease addition at the Bear Canyon Mine is at the discretion of Co-Op Mining Company. However, no mining except for the approved Incidental Boundary Change (IBC) may occur in this area prior to receipt of an approved permit from the Division.
