Re: Abatement of NOV 88-29-1-1, Co-Op Mining Company, Bear Canyon Mine, ACT/015/025, Folders No. 3 and 5, Emery County, Utah

According to your letter of October 14, 1988, abatement of NOV 88-29-1-1 is not possible until additional flexible pipe has been secured. Delivery was said to require two weeks.

As a result, the Division grants Bear Canyon Mine an extension for NOV abatement. All drainage controls must be in place by November 2, 1988. Please be aware that this date is 90 days from NOV issuance, and represents the maximum allowable time for abatement. Failure to complete drainage controls in accordance with the approved plan by November 2, 1988 will result in a Cessation Order.
