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Attached are four copies of Plate 3-4, and pages 1-2, 3-vi, 3-2, 3-99, 3I-2, 3I-3 and 3I-4. These are the pages and plates that reference portals in the mine and they have been updated to include the proposed additions. Basically two new portals are required; one for a future fan installation and one for the adjacent explosion door. The existing intake portals are also properly referenced in the text and on the map. Please review these items and notify me of any additional requirements that may be required for DOGM approval.

These additional portals are essential to meet safe mining and MSHA requirements etc. as mining reaches to the north of the mining property. This location is the farthest location to the north that will allow for horizontal access to the surface. Co-Op is now mining in the area and will soon be removing the belt and mining equipment from this area. A delay in approval would create mining delays and prove costly. If there are any questions please contact me or Mr. Owen at the mine. If approval can be accelerated with the use of reasonable stipulations that may be advantageous.
