The Division requests that Co-Op Mining Company complete the cleaning of Sediment Pond "A" by September 30, 1990. The pond currently is considered functionally inadequate based on the fact that half the pond remains at the maximum sediment level. If the pond is not adequately cleaned and surveyed to determine if it meets permitting designs, the pond will then be considered inadequate to handle the design storm and meet effluent limits.
