

I received a copy of the referenced NOV on 1 May 1991 from Co-Op Mining Co. I have discussed the issue with Co-Op and they have requested that I obtain additional information from the Division. Actions were in progress prior to receipt of the referenced NOV to determine the impacts the improved maps have on bonding. This work will continue and bonding (ltr of Credit) will be increased accordingly.

I was in contact with four other members of the Division on Friday 3 May 1991, and none of them were fully informed about this issue. Although I left many messages for you to return my calls you were apparently too busy. Please notify me and/or Co-Op, as dictated by Division policy, in writing, of the factors used to determine the requested amount (\$547,000). Due to the abatement conditions imposed with this NOV, your immediate response is requested.
