

ACT/015/025, Emery County, Utah

This letter is to notify the Division that diversions in question during the OSM inspection were regraded within two weeks following the 10-12 March 1992 inspection. Most of the diversions were in compliance, within the approved PAP specifications, at the time of the inspection and have been properly maintained. Division personnel have been on site and have had the opportunity to inspect conditions of the diversions following regrading.

The diversion calculations in the approved PAP were based on in-place measurements taken by EarthFax Engineering in 1990. Because the tabulated dimensions in the approved PAP were more than adequate Co-Op proposed to submit a revision to the PAP giving minimum requirements following Division requirements as part of the amendment to the NOV. In order to conform with the wishes of Hugh Klein, which he expressed today in a phone conversation with Charles Reynolds of M.E.C., I am submitting a separate letter to cover the proposal. Please notify me if there are any questions or concerns regarding this matter. I apologize for any inconvenience that this may have caused the Division.
