Company, Bear Canyon Mine, ACT/015/025

On April 14, 1992, the undersigned accompanied by Charles Reynolds made a field investigation of the work Bear Canyon Mine had performed. The work in response to violations issued by the Division is summarized below:

- (1) NOV 92-40-1-1, SBC-3 Bear Canyon Monitoring Well
  - ° On 4/14/92, observed work completed including concrete pad, 6" square metal protective casing, 4" PVC riser, and locking cap.
  - ° On 4/2/92, observed the grout poured around the PVC coupling. The concrete pad covers the grouted segment.
  - ° The work meets the specifications and design provided to me by fax dated 4/13/92.
- (2) NOV 92-40-3-1, 6" iron pipe, upper Bear Canyon Mine pad and adjacent to the belt line has been removed.

Recommend the aforementioned violations be terminated.
