Re: Culvert C-13U, Undisturbed Diversion, NOV #N91-40-2-2, Bear Canyon Mine, Co-Op Mining Company, ACT/015/025-92B, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

The Division is in receipt of two submittals (dated January 6 and 7, 1992) relative to the NOV noted above. Upon review of these plans, it has been determined that the requirements for abatement of this violation have not been met.

The updated maps and tables meet the requirements for abatement contained in the second part of the NOV. Abatement will be complete upon final submission of plates and maps which have a signed P.E. stamp.

Part one of the violation cannot be terminated because there was no specificity in the submittals as to the deepening of the ditch and reinstalling the culvert. A commitment should be made to complete the work as soon as the weather permits and by no later than April 15, 1992.

It must be noted that the culvert must be maintained so that it is operational or additional enforcement action may have to be taken.

Please submit all of the required information for a complete and adequate plan by January 29, 1992.
