
C.O.P. Coal Development Company has been in contact with Co-Op Mining Co. concerning development of the hunting rights within it's property in the Bear Canyon Area. In order to facilitate access to the upper sections of our property we will be constructing a road above the existing mining operation. The proposed road will extend from the existing mine access road to the south and then switch back and forth as required to reach the ridge area. A hunting lodge will be built near the ridge. In order to minimize disturbance in the area we propose to link the hunting access road with Co-Op Mining Co. proposed "Tank Seam Road".

Consultants have been hired to design the hunting access road, using good engineering practice. Where the road passes through the Manti-La Sal National Forest, construction will be coordinated with the Forest Service. We will make the maps available to the Division as requested.

Hunting in this area predates mining and we wish to make the best use of this resource on our property. Hunting will continue after mining has pulled out of the canyon and we will require that access be maintained following reclamation. We understand that this will impact Co-Op Mining Co. Reclamation Plan and we wish to coordinate with the Division on this matter.
