Enclosed are three copies of a proposal to abandon monitor well DH-3, and replace the monitoring point with a new well, DH-4. The location of DH-4 was chosen to increase the characterization of the Spring Canyon member of the Star Point Sandstone and give us a better knowledge of what the water is doing in the area of the coal seams as mining proceeds North.

The reason for the need to abandon the monitor well is because the pillaring in the East Bleeder section has reached the area of 1st East (Plate 3-4A), and the pillars around the well are scheduled to be pulled mid-October. The well abandonment will be performed by Zimmerman Well Service in accordance with all State and Federal regulations.

Pages and Plates have been marked DRAFT to distinguish them from previously approved pages and plates. Upon approval, finalized copies will be sent to the Division.
