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This letter is to inform the Division of the status of the coal storage pad interim reclamation as required by section 8.9.1 and approved in proposal 93D. Coal has been removed from the outslopes of the coal storage pad, and material from the area of sample site CSP-5 has been used for repairing erosion channels and expanding the storage pad as approved to prevent future spills onto the slope. Interim revegetation will be performed in the Spring of 1994 as soon as weather conditions permit. This was verbally discussed with Susan White during the December 20, 1993 complete inspection. Following reseeding, erosion control matting will be placed where necessary to increase the stability of the slopes.
