

Co-Op Mining Company has been informed that a more accurate survey of the subsidence conditions is necessary in order to mitigate the surface effects of the subsidence in accordance with the abatement requirements of NOV 94-46-4-1B. Currently, the ground in the area is covered with 6" to 12" of snow, making this survey and evaluation impossible at this time. Co-Op intends to conduct this survey in the spring as soon as the weather conditions allow us to.

In accordance with R645-400-327.400, Co-Op Mining Company requests an extension until May 15, 1995 to allow the mitigation evaluation to be conducted as soon as the snow melts, and allow time for the Division to review the mitigation plans following the survey.
