

NOTICE

The following notice of intent to construct, submitted in accordance with Section R307-1-3.1, Utah Air Conservation Rules, has been received for consideration by the Executive Secretary, Utah Air Quality Board:

Andalex Resources Incorporated

Location: No Street Address, Huntington, UT 84528

At end of Crandall Canyon road; per 6/19/95 letter in Inventory file: site purchased from Genwal Coal Company (now Genwal Resources)

Project Description: Approval Order Modification DAQE-044-96, for process change and coal production increase from current level of 2.5 to 4.00 million tons per year

The Proposed Emissions increase will be (A negative sign indicates a decrease in emission rates.):

TSP	-3.87 tons/year
PM ₁₀	-5.28 tons/year
SO ₂	-0.41 tons/year
NO _x	-3.20 tons/year
CO	1.16 tons/year
VOC	-0.23 tons/year

The engineering evaluation and air quality impact analysis have been completed and no new violations of National Ambient Air Quality Standards or Prevention of Significant Deterioration Increments will occur. It is the intent of the Executive Secretary to approve the construction project.

The construction proposal and estimates of the effect on local air quality are available for public inspection and comment at the Division of Air Quality, Utah State Department of Environmental Quality, 150 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4820. Written comments received by the Division, at the same address on or before August 17, 1997, will be considered in making the final decision on the approval/disapproval of the proposed construction.

If anyone so requests to the Executive Secretary at the Division in writing, within 15 days of publication of the Notice, a hearing will be held to explain the project and technical rationale for proposed action. A hearing will be scheduled as close as practicable to the proposed project location. Comments obtained during a hearing will be evaluated and considered by the Executive Secretary before making a final decision on the approval/disapproval of the project.
