I just processed the third quarter 2000 Bear Canyon Mine data. The data that was uploaded was from a file in which the sites and parameters had not been sorted and many site's data only included 1 or 2 parameters, the rest was truncated because the samples were not continuous. Charles Reynolds had emailed me the original file which I sorted in Excel and then uploaded into the Bear Canyon Mine EDI site. This fixed file is attached FYI.

I then used the lab and field sheets which had been supplied by Coop to OK and correct most problems. I did not have the sheets for FC-1 so I could not verify the question for this sample. FC-1 still remains in the pipeline. If Nephi could fix that one I will process it after that.

This removes all 3rd quarter 2000 data for Co-Op.

A reminder. Prior to uploading a file from the lab, the data person (Nephi) should do a sort on the entire file, sorting on Column B, the Site ID; then on Column D, the Lab Number; then on Column E, the Parameter Number. This sort procedure places all of the sample parameters together and reduces the loss of data due to it being split in the file. If you have any questions call me.
