

Board of Oil, Gas and Mining to Meet

The Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining will meet in regular session on March 26 in the auditorium of the Department of Natural Resources, 1594 West North Temple in Salt Lake City at 9 a.m.

Prior to the formal agenda that begins at 10:30 a.m. the board will hear from three nominees for 2003 Earth Day Awards. Earth Day Awards are presented to companies or individuals who go beyond what is required by regulation in their concern and care for the environment. Each nominee will take about 15 minutes to demonstrate to the board what has been accomplished to merit consideration for the award.

The three nominees making presentations are Co-Op Mining, Huntington; Northern Stone Supply, Oakley, Idaho; and the Utah State Office of the Bureau of Land Management. Following these presentations the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will give the board an update on related activity during the recently concluded legislative session.
