In response to your request for follow-up relative to the status of C.W. Mining's response to the Division's last deficiency document, Mark Reynolds indicated that he has everything ready to put into the USPS with the exception of the necessary signature on the C-1 form. He was in the process of obtaining that yesterday as we discussed the violation/inspection of the site. Also, he gave me a copy of the letter which is being sent to the EPA Region 8 office in Denver, as well as the DEQ/DWQ, the City of Huntington, etc. relative to the requirements of EPCRA Section 312, Tier II. This letter will address my concern relative to the deficiency which I aired in our last TA. According to Mark Reynolds, Jim Smith asked them to report the same drinking water information to the Division that they make to DEQ/DWQ. I believe their response to Jim's request is that if the Division wants that information, then we can obtain it from DWQ. I guess that's about it.
