Re: 2007 IBC, Bear Canyon Mine, C/015/025

We are submitting this amendment to allow mining on 126.93 acres of private coal. The surface owner of this area is the Forest Service. The legal description for the area being added is T16S R8E Section 19: Lot 1, NWNE, NENW. This area is being added in order to prevent C. W. Mining from having to stop one of our continuous miner sections and laying off half of our employees. The main area that is needed is approx 10 acres in the SW corner of lot 1 where the head gate entires of Longwall Panel 2 cross through this block. At the current speed we will reach our boundary in this location by the end of May.

Under our current plan this is the only area that is needed. The remaining area was added as a back up plan. If our development section that is in the head gate for Longwall Panel 1 reaches then end of the gate entries, and is not able to begin development of the bleeder entires, do to circumstances outside of our control, we would move that section to develop the main entires going into the block described above. This is not a desirable option for us since it would create four weeks of downtime for that section. Two weeks when we move to the main entires, and two weeks when we move back to the bleeders after the conditions preventing their development have been resolved.

At this time we are only requesting full support development mining in this block so no subsidence or surface impacts will occur.




