**1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale**

There are no pending amendments on file at the Division's office in Salt Lake. The permittee is currently correcting minor discrepancies in the legal description of the permit area boundary and preparing an application for phase three bond release on the old tank seam road. If there are no comments received by the end of the public comment period the Division could schedule the bond release inspection sometime in June.

**9. Protection of Fish, Wildlife and Related Environmental Issues**

Castle Valley Mining plans on conducting a raptor survey this year along the cliff habitat in areas where underground mining activities are within 1/2 mile of habitat that could be potentially subsided. To date there has been no subsidence from the current mining activities. Appendix O in chapter three of the MRP includes a mitigation plan for cliff nesting raptors that may be impacted by mining activities.

**22. Other**

A review of the PHC that was revised for the addition of the Bear Canyon lease in 2005 indicates that mining in the Hiawatha seam was contemplated. The list of references were provided to the permittee. They include from the electronic version pages 59, 71, 72, 76, 194, 228, 341 and 345 of 671. The corresponding CHIA should also be evaluated as Castle Valley Mining plans on mining in the Hiawatha seam this year.
