Enclosed is the corrected page one (1) of the Federal Permit for the Crandall Canyon Mine. The only corrected portion is in Section 2, line eleven, which now reads "permit #Act/015/132 issued October 22, 1982, including all...". That portion of the line to be removed is "issued October 22, 1982". The reason for the change is that the State of Utah has not issued a permit as of this date. That portion of line eleven was an error and is herein removed. This issue was discussed between Ron Naten and yourself on November 30, 1982. Line 11, Section 2, page 1 of the Crandall Canyon Federal Permit will be corrected to read, "Permit #ACT/015/132, including all stipulations, and all other..."

This permit, UT-0067 which incorporates Utah Permit #ACT/015/032 issued for United States of America by the Office of Surface Mining (OSM) to

for the Crandall Canyon Mine mine. Genwal Coal Company Inc. is the leasee of Federal Coal Lease SL-062648. The permit is not valid until a performance bond is filed with the OSM in the amount of \$135,374.78, (payable to the United States of America and the State of Utah), and the OSM has received a copy of this permit signed and dated by the permittee.

Sec. 1 STATUTES AND REGULATIONS - This permit is issued pursuant to the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977, 30 U.S.C. 1201 et seq., hereafter referred to as SMCRA, and the Federal coal leases issued pursuant to the Mineral Leasing Act of February 15, 1920, as amended, 30 U.S.C. 181 et seq., the Federal Coal Leasing Amendments Act of 1976, as amended 30 U.S.C. 201 et seq. and in the case of acquired lands, the Mineral Leasing Act for Acquired Lands of September 7, 1947, as amended, 30 U.S.C. 351 et seq. This permit is also subject to all regulations of the Secretary of the Interior including, but not limited to, 30 CFR 211 and Chapter VII and 43 CFR 3400, and to all regulations of the Secretary of Energy promulgated pursuant to Section 302 of the Department of Energy Organization Act of 1977, 42 U.S.C. 7152, which are now in force or, except as expressly limited herein, hereafter in force, and all such regulations are made a part hereof.

Sec. 2 The permittee is authorized to conduct surface coal mining and reclamation operations (as defined in 30 CFR 700.5 to include surface impacts incident to an underground coal mine) on the following described Federal lands (as shown on ownership map) within the permit area at the Crandall Canyon Mine situated in the State of Utah, Emery County, in the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 5, and the SE1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 6 in Township 16 South, Range 7 East, SLM., and to conduct surface and reclamation operations connected with mining on the foregoing described property subject to the conditions of the lease, the approved mining and reclamation plan (MRP), and Utah State permit #ACT/015/132, including all stipulations, and all other applicable conditions, laws and regulations.
