
Dear Al:

NOTICE OF DECISION

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated, 1953, Section 40-10-1 et seq.), and the "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Coal Mining Activities" (Final Rules of the Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining), the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has issued a permit to mine coal to Genwal Coal Company, Inc., for its permit application No. ACT/015/032. The Company will mine coal underground in accordance with the approved Mining and Reclamation Plan for the Crandall Canyon Mine associated with Federal Coal Leases SL-0626-48 and the following lands:

Township 16 South, Range 7 East

Section 5: All that Part of the N1/4 NW1/4 SW1/2 lying North of Crandall Creek.

and

Township 16 South, Range 7 East, SLM, Utah

Section 5, SW1/4 NW1/4

Section 6, SE1/4 NE1/4
