The Office of Surface Mining (OSM) has reviewed the above noted State response. Ten-Day Notice (TDN) #85-02-113-05 was written to address a lack of blasting and certification records during an OSM inspection at Genwall Coal, Crandall Canyon Mine. A reinspection by DOGM personnel indicated that the situation had been corrected and no enforcement action was warranted. OSM finds this action to be appropriate.

It must be noted that DOGM's response was received four days following the ten-day deadline. OSM finds this timeliness to be inappropriate.
