S. during the past five years. All mines operated by this company which have filed for or received permits must be named. Dates of permit approval and permit i.c. numbers should be listed.

UMC 782.18 Personal Injury and Property Damage Insurance
Information - PGL

The applicant should notify the Division of the name of the insurance carrier, policy number, and effective dates. An updated Certificate of Insurance should then be forthcoming for Division records.

UMC 784.14 Reclamation Plan: Protection of Hydrologic Balance - DC

The recently submitted seep and spring survey must be incorporated into the Tract 2 application.

TECHNICAL DEFICIENCY

UMC 817.52 Hydrologic Balance: Surface and Groundwater Monitoring - DC

After review of the fall seep and spring survey by the Division, a meeting with representatives of the Division of Wildlife Resources, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, and a representative of the Genwal Coal Company should be held in order to discuss and agree upon a ground water monitoring program acceptable to all parties. Based upon the fall seep and spring survey, a representative monitoring program and plans for mitigation can be determined.
