Re: Road Use Permit and Maintenance

Dear Reed,

In response to your concerns regarding the road maintenance in Crandall Canyon as required in the Road Use Permit issued to Genwal Coal Company and discussed during the recent meeting with your people on February 11, 1986, Genwal Coal will commit to the following road improvements during the 1986 construction season:


1. Apply Magnesium Chloride (or equivalent Brand Name) to the road surface to control dust. This treatment will be applied as soon as seasonal conditions permit, however, this will be done no later than June 15, 1986. During the summer Genwal Coal will evaluate the effectiveness of this treatment and during the fall of this year we will meet with your people to determine if additional measures will be needed to adequately control road surface loss and dust control.
2. Genwal Coal will monitor the tracking of road surface material on to Rt. 31 after the above Mag-Chloride is applied. If the tracking appears on Rt. 31, Genwal will be in contact with the UDOT to determine the severity and if it is determined that that tracking is a problem, Genwal will contact your people to determine what actions will be necessary to eliminate this hazard.
3. The cut slopes on the road where soil exists will be reclaimed in the Spring of 1986.
4. All other continuing maintenance as required in the road use permit will be done on an as needed basis.

It was a pleasure meeting with your people the other day and I would like to compliment them on their attitude of cooperation that was displayed during the meeting. Genwal realizes that there have been deficiencies in the road maintenance in the past and we will concentrate on improving these problems.
