

Dear Mr. Hedberg:

We have received and reviewed Genwal Coal Company's Permit Application Package (PAP) amendment for the Crandall Canyon Mine (Act/015/032-87A) to construct a tipple and loading facility at the mine site. The proposed tipple is on land administered by the Forest Service so the BLM has no comment to effects to the surface environment. The tipple will reduce loss of coal from handling and loading. In this respect, the proposed plan would aid in protection of the coal resource. Within the scope of our jurisdiction, the BLM recommends the PAP amendment be approved.
