### NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. N 87-16-1-1

Violation No. 1 of 1

Nature of violation

Failure to mine in accordance with an approved mine plan.  
Failure to obtain NPDES Permit prior to commencement of discharge  
from underground sump.
