Genwal Coal Company has recently lost the services of Cleveland Coal Sales as a contractor for the production of stoker coal and reduction of oversize material. Due to the abrupt and unforeseen circumstances surrounding the Cleveland Coal Sales departure, we must have the ability to reduce coal size at the mine site. This reduction process is needed to allow us to continue to service our present contracts.


At this time Genwal Coal hereby requests approval for the addition of an enclosed crusher to our temporary screening system located at the mine.

The crusher will be enclosed to contain fugitive dust. Water sprays will be applied to the throat of the crusher in the event of fugitive dust emissions. The crusher will be fed by a chute from the screen and an additional belt will be placed below the crusher to carry away the crushed product.

We anticipate approximately 275 tons of material to be crushed per day. This temporary crusher will be removed in conjunction with the approval for the temporary screen.
